General Information

Eligibility for Membership

- Open to all Royse City ISD students grades eighth through eleventh.
- All current members must tryout to maintain position on the team, although positions are not guaranteed.
- Student must be in good standing per UIL eligibility rules.
- Candidates are expected to attend all tryout practices.
- All candidates trying out, must be clear of all financial obligations from other school sponsored
 activities. This may include, but is not limited to, athletics, fine arts, library etc. It is the candidates
 responsibility to ensure that all balances and fines are taken care of. If the Director is aware of
 outstanding balances, the candidate may not try out.
- Tryout paperwork MUST be turned in to the Director by the set due date with no exceptions. Failure to do so will result in ineligibility to try out.
- Candidates will be evaluated by a panel of qualified judges from outside of RCISD.
- Judges will be selected by the Director.
- Tryouts will be closed to the public.

Requirements for Tryouts

- Return completed Golden Debs Application Packet by deadline.
- Attend all tryout practices prior to official tryout day.
- Tryout for judges on tryout day.

During Tryout Week

- All candidates must arrive at least 10 minutes early and be ready to practice.
- Tryout practices and official tryouts are closed to the public.
- For practices, candidates may wear comfortable, form fitting clothing or dancewear that will allow
 ease of movement while learning routines. Jazz shoes, dance shoes or tennis shoes will be
 acceptable. Hair must be pulled back out of the face and no jewelry or gum is allowed at any time.
- Numbers will be assigned to each candidate during the tryout week and candidates will be responsible for wearing the assigned numbers throughout the week and during the tryout in front of judges.
- Candidates are asked to remain quiet during stretching and instruction and will be given time to ask questions throughout the tryout week.

Day of Tryouts in Front of Judges

- Candidates must be in the main gym by 4:45 pm. Once official tryouts have begun, no one will be allowed in the areas being used for tryouts other than judges, Directors, and pre-approved RCHS teachers and administrators.
- Candidates must be in a black leotard or black tank top, black dance/work out pants (long or capri leggings), black sports bra, and dance shoes (jazz shoes, foot undies, half soles etc) or tennis shoes.
- You may <u>not</u> wear items you may have gotten from Debs if you were a previous member, even if it does not say "Debs" on it.
- Hair must be up and out of face with all strays pinned back and hair sprayed to prevent flyaways.
- Candidates will need to wear performance makeup with red lips. This will be covered in detail during the parent meeting and again during the tryout week.
- Candidates may be called back by judges so please remain stretched and calm.
- Once judges have completed the scoring process, all candidates will be dismissed.
- No jewelry or gum.

Selection Process

- The performance of a candidate will be evaluated and scored by a panel of qualified judges from outside RCISD.
- Judges will be selected by the Director. Every effort will be made to select judges who have no knowledge of the candidates and their abilities.
- Judging will be based on the following:

Execution and energy:1-10 points

Technique: 1-10 Turns: 1-10

Leaps/Jumps: 1-10 Projection: 1-10 <u>Kick Section:</u> Memory: 1-10

Technique/ Height: 1-10

Execution/Energy/ Projection: 1-10

Splits:

Right Split:1-5 Left Split: 1-5 Total: 100 points

- Judges will be choosing dancers for both Varsity and JV for the 2025-2026 school year. The
 judges will be using a 1-100 scoring process. The dancers will get to select if they are trying out
 for only JV, only Varsity, or both JV and Varsity.
- Dancers will be selected for JV and Varsity based on the biggest break in scoring.
- Friends and family will not be allowed in the dressing room, waiting areas, or any area with the candidates.
- Official results will be posted on our website at www.rchsgoldendebs.com and on our Debs instagram-rchsgoldendebs and Golden Debs Facebook by 10:30 PM the last day of tryouts.
- The dancers that make JV and Varsity debs will return to the dance building after the results are posted.
